### Safety Day

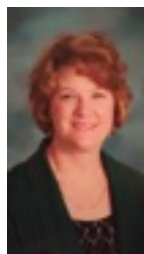
Safety Day was held on October 25. All of our students were able to visit various stations about Safety. The community came out to share safety tips with our students. Students really enjoyed the event.
