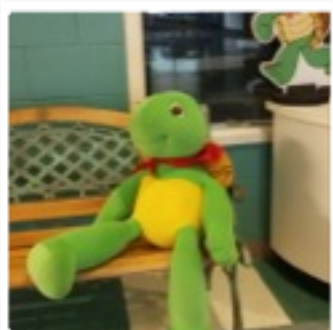
### PBIS Updates
