Things to Consider:

Kindergarten Registration - Please join us for one of the Kindergarten Registration Sessions at Perquimans Central School on the following dates and times: Thursday, March 28th from 1:00PM – 6:00 PM or Friday, March 29th from 9:00AM – 12:00 Noon. In order to enroll, the child must be 5 years of age on or before August 31, 2019. Please bring your child with you to registration! Parents will complete required paperwork for registration while children complete a Kindergarten screening.

Parents should bring the following to registration:

- Immunization Record
- Proof of Birth (ex. Birth Certificate)
- Social Security Card
- Proof of Residency (ex. electric bill, water bill, tax card, rental agreement, etc.)
- Kindergarten Physical (within one calendar year prior to school entry and must include vision and hearing screenings)

Pre-K Applications - Applications for Pre-K at Perquimans Central School for the 2019-2020 School Year are now being accepted. If your child will be four years old by August 31, 2019 he or she is eligible to apply for the NC Pre-K Program at Perquimans Central School. Applications can be picked up at PCS and must be turned in no later than March 22nd. Screenings will be held March 27th and 28th.

Please stop by the school cafeteria ASAP if you need to complete free and reduced lunch paperwork. Every family must re-apply for free/reduced meals each school year! A new application needs to be completed ASAP.

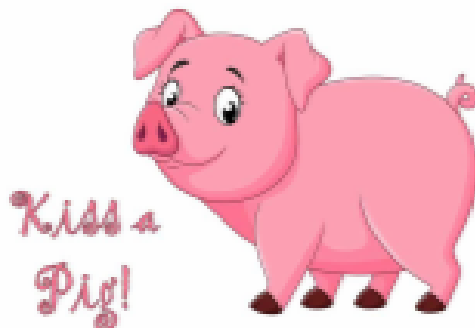
