Things to Consider:

Pre-K Applications - Applications for Pre-K at Perquimans Central School for the 2018-2019 School Year are now being accepted. If your child will be four years old by August 31, 2018 he or she is eligible to apply for the NC Pre-K Program at Perquimans Central School. Applications can be picked up at PCS and must be turned in no later than April 30th.
