Pre-K Applications - We are still accepting applications for Pre-K at Perquimans Central School for the 2019-2020 School Year are now being accepted. If your child will be four years old by August 31, 2019 he or she is eligible to apply for the NC Pre-K Program at Perquimans Central School. Applications can be picked up at PCS.

Cafeteria Charges - Please remember that Perquimans County Schools has a No Charge Policy for meals in the cafeteria. Students and adults should have money in hand or a pre-paid account set up. Accounts can be set up on-line at www.K12Paymentcenter.com or in person at the individual school cafe's. Please stop by the school cafeteria ASAP if you need to complete free and reduced lunch paperwork. Every family must re-apply for free/reduced meals each school year! A new application needs to be completed ASAP.

The class with the most Turtle Bucks each month will receive the Turtle Buck trophy.

-PBIS Main Events will be held each month to celebrate students who have no bus referrals and no discipline referrals documented in Educator's Handbook.

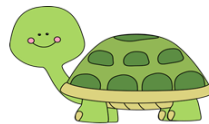

Thursday - after your *Curtain Call*, relax in the Green Room with a stocked fridge of snacks and drinks for you to enjoy!

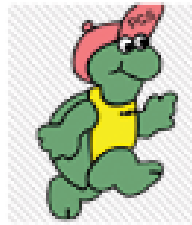
