Things to Consider:

Cafeteria Charges - Please remember that Perquimans County Schools has a No Charge Policy for meals in the cafeteria. Students and adults should have money in hand or a pre-paid account set up. Accounts can be set up on-line at www.K12Paymentcenter.com or in person at the individual school cafe's. Please stop by the school cafeteria ASAP if you need to complete free and reduced lunch paperwork. Every family must re-apply for free/reduced meals each school year! A new application needs to be completed for all students by September 15, 2018.

Pick Up Changes – <u>Beginning Monday, September 10th</u>, PCS will be implementing new procedures for car riders. Each family will receive 2 car tags to be hung on their rearview mirror. This will add a layer of safety and accountability to our procedures. You must display a car tag to go through the pick up line. If you do not have a car tag, you will have to go to the office, show a photo idea, and be listed on the child's emergency contact list.

Kiss and Go – The Kiss and Go policy will begin for Kindergarten on Monday, September 10th. We ask that all students walk unescorted to class in the mornings unless the parent has a scheduled appointment with a teacher. If a parent has a meeting with a teacher before school, they must sign in at the office using Lobby Guard before walking down the hall. Visitors will not be allowed in the hallway without a Lobby Guard badge. This helps us ensure safety by accounting for all individuals in the building. It also helps preserve instructional time and encourages our children to become independent learners.

Attendance Awareness Month – September is Attendance Awareness Month. We are working hard to help educate families about the importance of developing positive early attendance habits. Did you know that only 17% of students who are chronically absent in Kindergarten and 1st grade are reading on grade level in 3rd Grade!!! Every day in school matters!! This is the main reason that Perquimans County Schools has recently revised the Attendance Policy 4400.
